Colbert is celebrating 50 years of Fourth of July Festivities and the theme is "Honoring Our Roots ~ Family, Farming and Friends". We will be displaying an agricultural theme, so please incorporate this in your casual wear! Just call us for questions.

We will offer practices the week before the pageant times will be announced at the meeting. ALL CONTESTANTS must attend the practice Friday, May 17 at 6:30. Each contestant needs an escort if possible (father, brother, boyfriend, etc.)

Judging: Judges will judge you as follows: Interview (20 pts.), Poise and personality (20 pts.), Beauty (15 pts.), Pro-Am Modeling (15 pts.), Dress (15 pts.) and Stage Question (15 pts.). Judges will also judge you on your interview prior to the pageant that evening.

*** If you are crowned this year, next year you are required to perform a talent at the 2020 Pageant. You are also required to ride in Colbert's 4th of July parade, Comer Christmas parade, Winterville Marigold parade and a possible 4th parade. YOU are responsible for having a convertible for each parade. You will also be required to represent our community in Colbert's Old Fashion Christmas, held in Colbert.
