Adoption of All Ordinances and Contracts: Motion made by Evelyn Power and seconded by Roger Fortson to adopt all ordinances and contracts for 2020.

Grass Cutting Update: Recommended that the grass-cutters be allowed to weed-eat tops of graves inside coping as needed. No spraying allowed. It was also brought up to mention that they need to cut city right-of-way down to the ditch line.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Billboard Ordinance – Attorney Perry presented amendment to the sign ordinance (attached). This amendment will require a permit to place a sign in the future on any property located within the city limits. Any signs already in place are grandfathered in and will not be required to meet these guidelines. Evelyn Power made a motion to amend the sign ordinance as presented and motion was seconded by Jonathan Pou. All approved.

Attorney Perry explained that the Southern Light Company had requested a permit to run internet cable inside city limits. The City has no obligation to issue a permit for this service since it is approved through the state.

Bids on remodeling the old school for office space was tabled due to waiting on more bids.
